ORDINANCE 18-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELDOVIA, ALASKA, ADOPTING CHAPTER 10.18 MISCELLANEOUS STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, AMENDING TITLE 10.16 PARKING TO READ PARKING LOT REGULATIONS AND MOVING 10.16.015 PARKING DURING SNOW PROHIBITED TO 10.18.070

SECTION 1. CLASSIFICATION: This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall become a part of the Municipal Code of the City of Seldovia.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to another person or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 3. AMENDING TITLE 10 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC BY ADDING LANGUAGE IN HIGHLIGHT TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 4. AMENDING CHAPTER 10.16 PARKING BY REMOVING LANGUAGE IN STRIKEOUT AND ADDING LANGUAGE IN HIGHLIGHT TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 10.16 Parking Lot Regulations

10.16.015 Parking During Snow Prohibited. Parking on any existing city street and right of way shall be prohibited from November 1st through April 30th during the period of four a.m. to four p.m., provided, however, this

~~prohibition shall apply only when there has been an accumulation of four inches or more of snowfall in the previous forty-eight hours.~~

SECTION 5. ADOPTING CHAPTER 10.18 MISCELLANEOUS STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

10.18.010 Places where prohibited. A. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law, regulation or ordinance, or the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:

1. On a sidewalk;
2. In front of a public or private driveway;
3. Within thirty (30) feet of an intersection;
4. Within eight feet of a fire hydrant when that hydrant is directly adjacent to the curb; where a fire hydrant is recessed back from the curb, within eight feet of that point on the curb which would be crossed by a perpendicular line from the recessed hydrant to the nearest public street;
5. On a crosswalk;
6. Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
7. On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
8. Upon any bridge;
9. At any place where official signs prohibit stopping;
10. All street areas adjacent to curbs painted yellow.

(b) No person shall move a vehicle not lawfully under his control into any such prohibited area or away from a curb such distance as is unlawful.

10.18.020 City streets parking prohibited. No vehicle shall be stopped, left standing or parked for more than two hours on any portion of the following streets:

1. Inlet Street
2. Service Lane
3. Garden Street
4. Lipke Lane
5. Cedar Street
6. Willow Street
7. Kachemak Street
8. Lindstedt Lane
9. South Easterly side of Alder Street between Kachemak Street and Cedar Street
10. English Drive

10.18.030 Parking in streets and alleys. No person shall park a vehicle in any street or alley in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than 10 feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic; and no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle therein in such position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property.

10.18.040 Parking for certain purposes prohibited. No person shall park a vehicle upon any roadway for the principal purpose of:

1. Displaying such vehicle for sale;
2. Washing, greasing or repairing such vehicle except repairs necessitated by an emergency.

10.18.050 Parking in excess of 72 hours prohibited. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle or trailer, whether attended or unattended, on any street for a period longer than 72 hours unless otherwise signed.

10.18.060 Parking of nonmotorized vehicles on narrow roadways. Except as permitted under this section, no person shall park a trailer, boat trailer or other nonmotorized vehicle on any roadway which is twenty-eight (28) feet or less in width;

A. A trailer, boat trailer or other nonmotorized vehicle shall be considered to be illegally parked under this section even if the trailer, boat trailer or other nonmotorized vehicle is hitched or otherwise connected to a motor vehicle.

B. Temporary parking of trailers or other nonmotorized vehicles may be permitted by the City Manager when necessary to avoid other undue hardship on the owners or residents of adjacent property or their contractors.

10.18.070 Parking During Snow-Prohibited. Parking on any existing city street and right-of-way shall be prohibited from November 1st through April 30th during the period of four a.m. to four p.m., provided, however, this prohibition shall apply only when there has been an accumulation of four inches or more of snowfall in the previous forty-eight hours.
